Change: Section 512.3 Provider Agency Certification under the header Becoming a Certified TBIW Provider -the 23 rd bullet down. "Office Emergency Back-Up Plan ensuring office staffing and facilities are in place during emergencies such as floods, fires, etc. The alternate site can be used for 30 days. If the agency will be there longer than 30 days the new temporary facilities must meet all requirements and the location be recertified. The provider must notify the UMC within 48 hours of the location change. Providers must inform members receiving TBIW services of their Emergency Back-Up Plan. "
